Ramaciotti Health Investment Grants of up to \$100,000 are awarded to individuals for a contribution towards the undertaking of health or medical research with the potential path to clinical application within five years. Grants are awarded by Perpetual, as trustee of the Ramaciotti Foundations, on the recommendation of the Ramaciotti Scientific Advisory Committee.
